

April 4, 2016 @ 7:00pm**Regular Meeting**

Chairman Dave Anderson called the April meeting to order. Supervisors present were Jimmie Roach, Dave Hauser. Also present Treasurer Dominic Henderson and clerk A. Anderson.

All stood for the pledge of allegiance.

March minutes were reviewed by all. J. Roach made a motion to accept the March minutes as written, D. Hauser seconded. All were in favor.

Treasurer's report was reviewed by Henderson. Receipts for March were in the amount of \$16,710.87. Disbursements were \$38,804.14, leaving a balance as of March 28th in the amount of \$625,573.11. D. Anderson made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as presented, D. Hauser seconded. All were in favor.

J. Roach made a motion to approve the Liquor License for Brenda at Sportsman's Store. D. Hauser seconded and all were in favor.

Crosslake Police reported by Officer Bobbie Willard. There had been 25 calls in February and 37 calls in March.

Fire Chief Randy Roach reported on 4 calls for March. Two were in Center Township, one mutual aid and one in Mission Township. Total calls year-to-date have been 19. Chief stated that they have received an EMS grant. Chief discussed the live burn training that was held on March 12th at the Quarterdeck. A new fire applicant was reviewed for Blake Mortensen. J. Roach made a motion to accept Blake Mortensen as a new fire fighter applicant. D. Hauser seconded and all were in favor.

Recycle – J. Roach stated he would like to have the recycle pads extended so in the summer months there can be additional bins for recycling.

Fire Relief – There was nothing new to report.

Road & Bridge - D. Anderson had drove the roads, there was a lot of sand. There was discussion regarding a sweeper. Anderson stated that renting a large sweeper would be a better option than purchasing one. Signs will continue to be put up this spring. D. Anderson will get together with Anderson Bros. after the Road Inspection to discuss paving at the same time as the County to help with costs.

Park & Recreation – Carl Anderson stated that the park has been cleaned. Tennis courts are ready for the season. May 8th & 9th there will be 500 trees planted. C. Anderson asked for approval to remove 4 pines in the area of the current storage garage to make room for the addition. J. Roach made a motion to remove the 4 trees, D. Hauser seconded. All were in favor. There was discussion regarding making the Independence Day parade an extended educational event at the same time.

Comprehensive Plan – Terry Havar stated that the mailbox support bracket information is on the website. Havar asked if the website address could be placed under the current township sign. Henderson asked about placing a flag pole in front of the Town Hall. Board will take a look at the option during the road inspection.
