

November 2, 2015 @ 7:00pm Regular Meeting

Chairman Dave Anderson called the November meeting to order. Supervisors present were Dave Hauser, Jimmie Roach and clerk A. Anderson.

All stood for the pledge of allegiance.

October minutes were reviewed by all. D. Anderson made a motion to accept the October minutes as written, D. Hauser seconded. All were in favor.

Clerk reviewed the treasurer's report as prepared by Henderson. Receipts were in the amount of \$197.00. Disbursements were \$15,003.00, leaving a balance of \$563,739.40. J. Roach made a motion to accept the treasurer's report, D. Hauser seconded. All were in favor.

Crosslake Police Office Bobbie Willard reported on 32 calls for October. Willard also stated that the Property Watch forms are available. You can get the form off the township website 'missiontownship.org', the Crosslake Police Dept. or from the clerk (765-4377).

Fire Chief Randy Roach reported on 7 calls for October. 3 were in Center Township and 4 in Mission. Total calls for the year have been 102. Fire Dept. had received two different donations of \$500 for the Lucas Device. They are still seeking out grants.

J. Roach reported that the smaller recycle bins have been working well. They are being changed out on a regular basis and not as much wasted space in the bin. There will be a quarterly Fire Relief meeting on Nov. 30 @ 7pm. The mandatory township contribution is needed.

D. Anderson stated that Jim Van Horn should be starting to Right of Way trimming soon. Roads are in good condition. D. Hauser stated a resident had asked him about the possibility of having rumble strips placed at Cty. 3 and Cty. 11. Anderson stated that would be a county issue.

Park & Rec. – Blassey has emptied the aluminum can bin. He has got the 'No Hunting' signs posted. Blassey has been in contact with Natural Resource Manager – Ryan Simonson, in reference to cut-to-length operations. Simonson would highly recommend this type of operation for thinning out the aspen/pine trees in April or May. Martha Steele has been in search of grants for the tennis courts. There is a need for a committee of tennis orientated people to help with this project. There has been some interest in 'Pickle Ball'. Next year they will look at placing the lines needed for this onto the basketball court. Blassey has also become aware of a grant for pollinating the land that has been timbered. Trails have been mowed and brushed.

Comprehensive Plan – Terry Havar stated that the website is up and running. It is still a work in progress. Check it out at 'missiontownship.org'.

Cemetery – Donnie Berg stated there was one burial. The new section of the cemetery has been replotted. Roads need to be mowed in the new section.

Transfer Station – Dale Van Horn stated that the transfer station is closed for the season and will re-open in April.

Old Business – D. Hauser called a couple of rental companies about ground thawing devices.

New Business – There was nothing to report.

Claims for November were reviewed. D. Anderson made a motion to pay claims 7668 – 7684 in the amount of \$14,537.25. D. Hauser seconded, all were in favor.

D. Hauser made a motion to adjourn the November meeting, J. Roach seconded. All were in favor.
