

August 4, 2014 7:00pm Regular Meeting

Chairman Dave Anderson called the meeting to order. Supervisors present; Jimmie Roach, Jerry Speedling and Anderson. Also present; clerk A. Anderson. There were 8 residents in attendance.

All stood for the pledge of allegiance.

July minutes were reviewed by all. Anderson made a motion to accept the July minutes as written. J. Roach second, all in favor.

Treasurer's report was given by clerk A. Anderson, in the absence of Henderson. Receipts for July were \$2,560.46. Disbursements were \$31,364.00, leaving a balance of \$567,370.00. Anderson made a motion to accept the treasurers report, Speedling seconded. All in favor.

Crosslake Police Office Jake Maier reported on 37 calls for June and 36 calls for July. Maier stated that it has been a busy two months.

Fire Department was reported by Assistant Chief J. Roach. There were 15 calls for July, 72 total calls for the year. Fire dept. is still looking for grants for the Lucas Device. Chairman Anderson had received a resignation letter from firefighter Mark Myer.

Road reported by Speedling, Elise Van Horn has been out cleaning up the right of way along the township roads. J. Roach stated that the fire department was called out during the last storm. They were out cleaning up trees from 12:00pm to 6:00am. Thanks to all on the clean-up crew. Anderson Bros. has started the road maintenance. Havar stated the township should consider placing a flashing speed limit sign on Cty. Rd. 3 within the 45 MPH zone.

Park was reported by Michael Blassey. There were quite a few trees down on the paved trails in the park. Chuck Anderson has cleared some. Fertilizer has been put on the ball field. Blassey made a suggestion that the township should consider expanding the parking lot in the future.

Cemetery had nothing to report. There will be a Special Meeting on September 8, 2014 @ 7:00pm to discuss the Cemetery.

Transfer station was reported by Dale Van Horn, stating that brush is still coming in for disposal.

Comprehensive Plan reported by Terry Havar. Postcards for the survey have been sent out. There have been 80 surveys completed online.

New Business - nothing.

Anderson made a motion to pay claims 7287 – 7307 in the amount of \$98,425.83, J. Roach seconded. All in favor.

Anderson made a motion to adjourn the August meeting, Speedling seconded. Motion carried.
