The township board continued to meet on the first Monday of every month to conduct Township Business. In addition, there were several special meetings held during the year. During the year the board appointed a new treasurer and appointed a new supervisor to fill a vacated opening. The board completed the following during the year:

- Reviewed and updated the township cemetery policies and procedures.
- Reviewed and updated the transfer station policies and procedures.
- Completed a review of the township operating policies, updated some policies and approved new resolutions.
- Applied for American Rescue Plan (ARPA) funds and will receive a total of \$93,764.00. There are some specific covid related areas where the monies can be spent and recent changes broaden the areas.
- Received a matching DNR Legacy grant for improvements to the park.
- Held an open house to solicit feedback on the capital improvement projects.
- Oversaw the completion of road maintenance and snow plowing.
- The township board continues to promote and support Mission Township culture as defined in the township comprehensive plan.

The township board continues to supervise the township assets and amenities. The board is committed to provide residents a safe place to live overseeing fire and police protection.
