September was a great weather month for the park with all activities being utilized. Because of the weather all of the sports equipment were left in place. Equipment will now start to come down this month as the weather is changing and we will prepare for the cold weather.

Projects that will be completed the month of October:

1. Restroom holding tanks were cleaned on October 5th.
2. On October 4th our water pressure tank sprung a leak and we had to turn the water off.
WE WILL NEED TO REPAIR AS SOON AS POSSIBLE BEFORE FREEZING TEMPATURES ARRIVE IF POSSIBLE. Jim Peterson is checking on the availability of a plumber. We need to fill our
restroom holding tank with water. Bob Steele will check with the fire dept on Tue Oct 10th to see if they could use FD tanker to accomplish.
3. Sports will be put away for winter. Completion date will be October 20th.
4. Switch out Park tractor from summer setup to winter setup.

Major expenses anticipated for October:

1. Repair of water pressure tank and updating of the system to code. Cost unknown at this time.
2. No other major expenses are anticipated.
