

MISSION TOWNSHIP CROW WING COUNTY, MINNESOTA Resolution 2023-24

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE OPTIONAL HOLIDAY DAYS AS NOT HOLIDAYS in 2024

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 645.44, Subd. 5 gives political subdivisions the option of determining whether Christopher Columbus Day (the second Monday in October) will be a holiday;

WHEREAS, no public business may be transacted on any holiday except the optional holiday days if the political subdivisions designates them as not holidays;

WHEREAS, the Town Board determines there are already a significant number of holidays designated by statute;

WHEREAS, the Town Board determines it is in the public's interest to not further limit the days on which public business may be transacted;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the town board of Mission Township, Crow Wing County, Minnesota determines and hereby designates Christopher Columbus Day as not a holiday in 2024 and so public business may be transacted thereon.
