2024 Annual Meeting – March 12, 2024



It is my honor to present the 2023 Mission Township Fire Department Annual Report to the town board and the citizens of Mission Township.

In the past year the Mission Township Fire Department has answered a total of 140 calls for service. We continue to ensure the safety and well-being of our community.

Here is a breakdown of the calls for service for 2023:

Our dedicated membership has invested over 2,000 hours of training and refining skills, while staying up to date on firefighting techniques and enhancing department readiness.

We are currently re-structuring the fire departments leadership structure to allow for a more stable leadership. We are going from 3 Chiefs, 2 Captains and 5 Lieutenants to 1 Chief, 1 Assistant Chief, 2 Captains, and 3 Lieutenants. One of the Lieutenants will be a Driver/Engineer.

We are also re-structuring our meeting and training schedule for the 2024 year. We will be going from monthly department meetings to bi-monthly meetings. We will also be reducing the number of trainings that we do in June, July and August to allow our members to spend more time with their families during the summer months.
