**RESOLUTION APPROVING SUMMARY LANGUAGE FOR
PUBLICATION OF AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TOWN RIGHTS-OF-WAY**

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2024, the Town Board of Mission Township adopted ordinance No. 2024-01 “Mission Township Right-of-Way Ordinance” (“Ordinance”);

WHEREAS, it is not practical to publish the entire text of the Ordinance in the Town’s official newspaper;

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute, section 365.125, subdivision 2 allows the publication of a summary of an ordinance instead of publishing the entire ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board determines publication of a summary of the Ordinance is sufficient to clearly inform the public of the intent and effect of the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby determines to publish the following summary language, which is hereby approved, in lieu of publishing the full text of the Ordinance:

**MISSION TOWNSHIP RIGHT-OF-WAY ORDINANCE
Ordinance 2024-01**

The Town Board adopted Ordinance No. 2024-01 to impose regulations to protect the Town’s road rights-of-way from interference and damage, and to protect public safety. The ordinance prohibits activities that may damage or otherwise interfere with the Town’s roads and drainage and establishes a process for enforcing the regulations. A copy of the full ordinance is available at the Crosslake Area Library, is posted on the Town’s website, and is available by contacting the Town Clerk.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to:

- (a) Publish the approved summary language set out above once in the Town’s official newspaper;

- (b) Post a copy of the full Ordinance on the Town’s website;
- (c) Maintain a copy of the full Ordinance in the Clerk’s office;
- (d) Place a copy of the full Ordinance at the Crosslake Area Library;
- (e) Place a copy of the full Ordinance at the Crow Wing County Law Library; and
- (f) Place the Ordinance in the Town Ordinance Book within 20 days together with a copy of the affidavit of having published the approved summary language.
