**RESOLUTION REGARDING SS4A PLANNING GRANT**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Mission is responsible to provide for streets and other transportation facilities such as trails and sidewalks to connect people, goods, and services in a safe and equitable manner; and

**WHEREAS**, the USDOT has established a program prioritizing traffic safety, including vulnerable users, referred to as Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A); and

**WHEREAS**, the SS4A program allows for Co-Applicants; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Crosslake has agreed to lead a SS4A planning effort, if funded by the USDOT, including townships in the resort area of northern Crow Wing County, Minnesota, and eastern Cass County, Minnesota;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of Mission agrees to be a Co-Applicant to the City of Crosslake’s application for a SS4A planning grant through the USDOT to develop a Safety Action Plan with a particular focus on vulnerable users. The Township of Mission also agrees to be an active participant in the development of the plan.
