


- Driveway Connections
 - Driveways will be connected 5' off the edge of the roadway with material matching the existing driveway
 - Gravel, Bituminous, Concrete
 - Concrete – No access while concrete curing



NOTE: CONTRACTOR SHALL PLACE TACK OIL AT RATE OF 0.08 GALLONS PER SQUARE YARD PRIOR TO OVERLAYING DRIVEWAY CONNECTIONS TO MATCH RAISED ROAD ELEVATION. QUANTITY FOR DRIVEWAY PAVING IS INCLUDED IN BITUMINOUS WEAR COURSE PAY ITEM.

Proposed Improvement


- Driveway Connections
 - Driveways will be connected 5' off the edge of the roadway with material matching the existing driveway
 - Gravel, Bituminous, Concrete
 - Concrete – No access while concrete curing





Proposed Improvement

- Mailbox Supports
 - Per Township Policy swing away mailbox supports will be installed where not currently present.
 - Existing swing away supports will be adjusted vertically.





Proposed Improvement

- Where manicured lawns abut the pavement; topsoil borrow shall be blended in over a four-foot-wide area and seeded.
 - Property Owner will be responsible to adjust irrigation heads.



Project Schedule



- Start Date is Currently Unknown
- We estimate construction will take approximately 2-3 weeks*
 - Reclaim existing pavement
 - Small amount of grading on north end
 - Concrete driveway connections and curing time
 - Shape and compact roadway base
 - Paving
 - Shouldering
 - Seeding


County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 11 2026 Resurfacing Project

CROW WING COUNTY RIDE QUALITY INDEX




